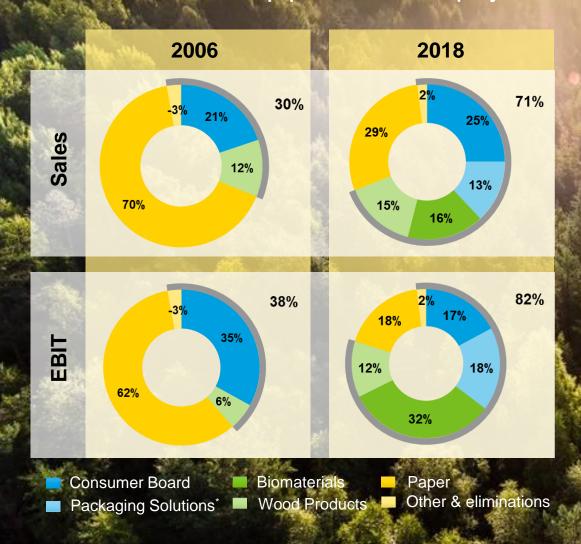




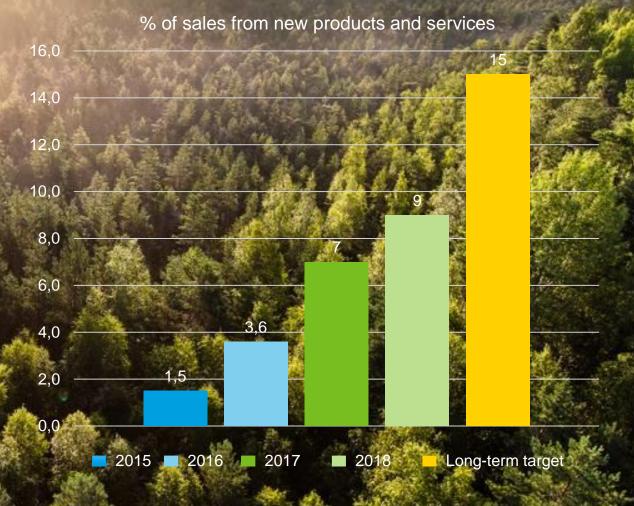

Cooperate with business and partners to consolidate core IT services

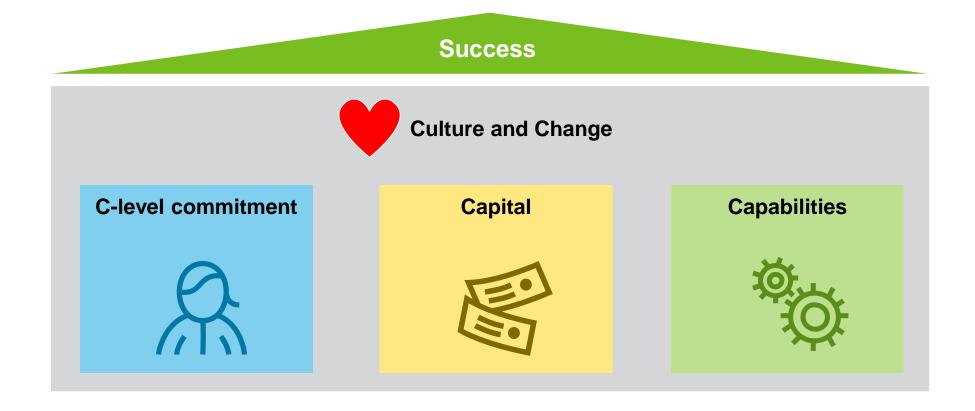

Sustained transformation demands c-level commitment and learning

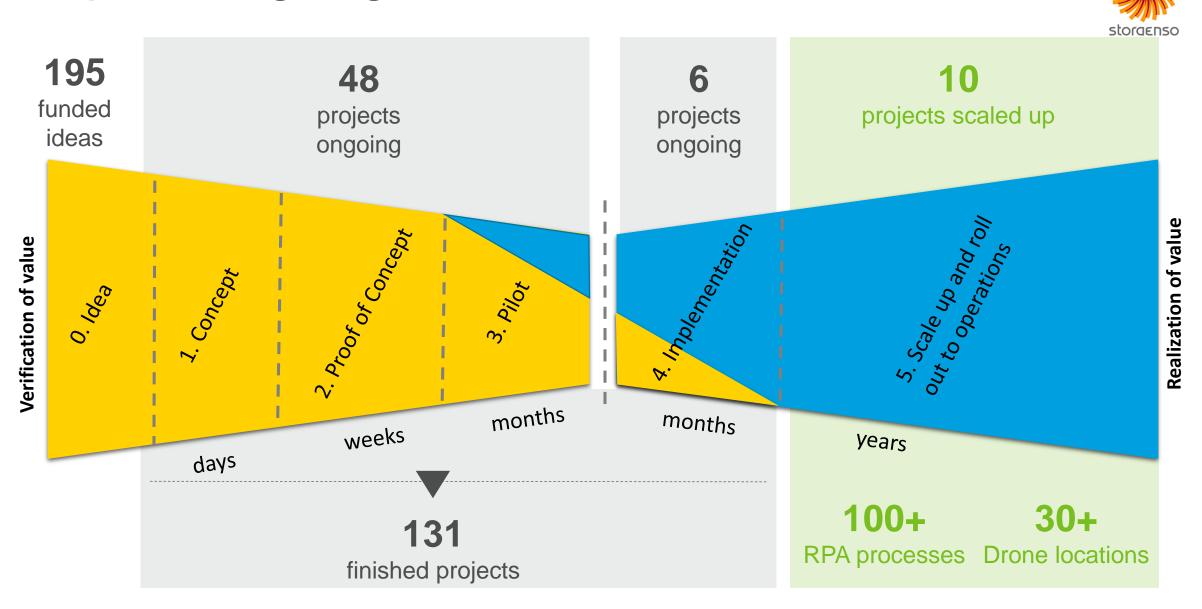








Capital through Digi Fund – with scale out focus in 2021

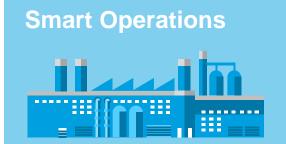
